OUTINGS

On April 24th 1937

When you were only a year JOURNEYS
and 7 months old, Daddy received a telegram
from Department of Agriculture telling him
to report at Weather bureau station at Wichita
Kansas. Daddy left that same day and Mother
and you stayed at Grandma Nicholas' house.
Mother packed her things, and released the
house on May 1, and stored her furniture in
Grandma Lacie's house ^{at Neligh} and then you and
Mother visited amongst relatives. He
went to Madison So. Dak. to see Aunt Alma and
Cousin Ruth, to Sioux City, Emerson and Stakefield.

Then on May 31, 1937 you and Mother
took the train from Neligh and started for
Wichita Kansas to be with Daddy, arriving
here at 7:30 P.M. June 1 and established a home
at 1135 No. Topeka Ave. On Sept. 13th we moved
in Duplex at 718 So Wichita Ave.

Daddy bought our first car a Ford V-8-60-
the 9th of November and on the 20th of Nov. we drove
up to see relatives in Nebraska.
